



Clothing Recycling Host a Bin

The Cerebral Palsy Association of BC works to create a life with out limits for people with cerebral palsy and other disabilities. Cerebral palsy is the most common physical disability in childhood and affects about 10,000 people in BC.

Our clothing recycling program provides people with a convenient way to get rid of unwanted clothes while supporting a great cause. Proceeds from donated clothes go to support our programs and services, like therapeutic yoga, adapted dance, pre-employment training, scholarships and bursaries.

To host a clothing recycling bin, all you need to do is provide the space to store the bin. We take care of the rest! We work with our partners to arrange regular pick-ups – at least once a week – and our drivers ensure your space is kept tidy.

By hosting a bin, your organization can:

- support a local charity,
- show a commitment to improving our environment by recycling,
- give residents an convenient way to donate old clothing and
- help to keep garbage and recycling areas in residential buildings free of clutter.

Our outdoor bins are 45" x 39" x 73" and are theft and fire-proof. Since the bins are made of metal, they can be placed either inside or outside. We also have smaller indoor bins to accommodate any space.
